#### Introduction to Rheinland-Pfalz

Two volumes of the Map Guide to German Parish Registers are needed for this region: Vol. 12, "Kingdom of Prussia Province of Rhineland II" and Vol. 13, Kingdom of Prussia Province of Rhineland III and Kingdom of Bavaria Palatinate (Pfalz)." It is the latter — specifically for the Palatinate/Pfalz section — that will refer to the greater number of Ortssippenbücher that we have for this part of Germany. "Rheinland" generally refers historically to the Prussian province of 1824 and later
